SPEAKERS

Charles R. Honts, Ph. D.: Dr. Charles Honts is a Professor with the Department of Psychology in Boise State University. He earned his Ph.D. in Psychology in 1986 from the University of Utah. Dr. Honts' research interests have involved scientific credibility assessment with adults and children, specifically the psychophysiological detection of deception. Other interests include quantitative methods, jury behavior, and the area of psychology and the law. A prolific author, Dr. Honts has published in the Journal of Police and Criminal Psychology, Applied Psychophysiology and Biofeedback, and Legal and Criminological Psychology. Additionally, he has served as a reviewer for a variety of publications and in 1996 founded the Journal of Credibility Assessment and Witness Psychology.

Erika E. Thiel, LPC: Ms. Erika Thiel is a Board Member with the APA and serves as the Chair of the APA PCSOT Committee. She is a licensed professional counselor and polygraph program manager, specializing in Post-Conviction Sex Offender Testing (PCSOT).
